After arguing for some time, when this court was not inclined to entertain this petition seeking direction to the respondent bank to grant some time to the petitioner to re-pay the loan amount, learned counsel prayed that the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to pursue the respondent bank for granting him more time to make payment of the loan amount, or to avail remedy under the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty. If the petitioner approaches the respondent bank with the aforesaid request, the

respondent bank shall consider the same keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case.
