Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.1 to remove respondent no.3 from the post of president in terms of provisions of Section 22 of the Punjab Municipal Act, 1911.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of issuing show cause notice dated 08.09.2014 (Annexure P/4) to respondent no.3, no action has been taken till date.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the

case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents

authorities, to pass an appropriate order on the show cause notice (Annexure P/4) in accordance with law. The petitioner will be at liberty to submit a comprehensive representation. Needful shall be done within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
