It has been argued by the learned counsel appearing on all sides that this petition should be transferred to the Tribunal which has been constituted by notification dated 02.03.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that there is an interim order in his favour and this Court should confirm the said order.

On the other hand, learned Senior counsel for respondents No.1 and 4 has urged that the prayer for continuation of the interim order should be left to be decided by the Tribunal as per law.

I find merit in the arguments of the learned Senior counsel for respondents No.1 and 4. It is clarified that the plea for continuation/vacation of the interim order shall be decided by the Tribunal as per law. Needless to say that both the parties of the lis would be entitled to raise all pleas available to them as per law before the Tribunal so that the prayer for continuation/vacation of the interim order can be decided before the next date in the contempt Court which is stated to be 21.04.2015.
