This writ petition has been filed in public interest for quashing the allotment of land allotted vide letter dated 20.11.1989 (Annexure P-4), on the ground that the said land was meant for public road/street and it was wrongly allotted to respondents No.6 to 8.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and going through the contents of the petition, we are not inclined to entertain this petition at this belated stage.

A copy of the letter dated 13.07.1984 (Annexure P-3) indicates that in the year 1984, a decision was taken to allot the land in question, i.e. behind Plot No. O-24, Industrial Area, Panipat, which was shown as a road, since the road has been closed. In this regard, an approval was also taken

from Municipal Committee, Panipat, to sell that area to the owners of the adjoining factories.

While taking into consideration these facts and the Policy of the State Government existing at that time, the land in question was allotted to owners of the adjoining factories in the year 1989. Now, at this belated stage, after 26 years, we are not inclined to entertain this petition and accept the contention of the petitioner that the said land was part of the road and could not be sold, particularly when that was abandoned road and No Objection was taken from the Municipal Committee regarding sale of the said land.

Dismissed.
