Reply by Smt. Promila, Deputy Secretary
(Establishment), Punjab School Education Board, Sahibzada
Ajit Singh Nagar on behalf of respondent No. 1 has been filed
in court today with a copy thereof to learned counsel for the
petitioner. Same is taken on record subject to just
exceptions.

Mr. S.S. Behl, learned counsel for respondent No. 1
submits that claim as raised in this writ petition has been
satisfied, thereby rendering this writ petition infructuous.
Family pension of the petitioner has been revised by
stepping up the pay of petitioner's husband at par with his

junior, reserve category employees w.e.f. 08.04.2008 to 30.04.2015. Amount of ₹1,68,460/- has been deposited in the petitioner's pension account vide cheque No. 656217 dated 17.09.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the aforementioned factual position.

In view of the above, this writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
