Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is only claim of gratuity which remains pending. Other reliefs have been afforded to the petitioner during the pendency of this writ petition. It is submitted that petitioner is due to retire on 15.02.2016

Learned counsel for respondents No. 3 and 4 submits that entire amount of gratuity due towards the petitioner for the period for which he worked with the respondent-institution, shall be transferred to the account of his present employer i.e. S.D. College Hoshiarpur within three weeks.

In view of the facts and circumstances as above this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No. 3 and 4 to transfer the abovesaid amount in the account of petitioner's present

employer within four weeks from date of receipt of certified copy of
this order.
