Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing order dated 31.03.2014 (Annexure P/10) passed by Naib Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Rewari and order dated 12.08.2015 (Annexure P/11) passed by the Financial Commissioner, Haryana.

in yellow and pink colours in the site plan (Annexure P/13) belongs to the petitioners and their mother and the same should have been consolidated in one khewat.

From the perusal of clause 1 of mode of partition (Annexure P/5), it is clear that six separate khewats/taks are required to be carved out. So, accordingly, six khewats/separate taks have been made. The partition has been effected in accordance with mode of partition.

No ground for interference is made out.
