Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to immediately correct the name, date of birth, name of police station concerning the place of birth of the petitioner in the birth certificate dated 10.10.2011 (Annexure P/2) and issue a fresh birth certificate to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has already made a representation dated 10.08.2013 (Annexure P/4), but till date no decision has been taken.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after

perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the

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case, instant petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to the respondents, to look into the grievance of the petitioner specifically made in representation dated 10.08.2013 (Annexure P/4) and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
