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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is claimant's appeal for enhancement of compensation against the award dated 4.11.2009, passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, (in short 'the Tribunal').

In this case, the claimant received four injuries. There are medical bills to the tune of Rs. 6,964/-. The claimant remained admitted in the hospital for five days. The injuries were found to be simple in nature. The Tribunal awarded compensation of Rs. 9,464/- on account of pecuniary loss.

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I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have
also carefully gone through the file.

Due to the injuries, the claimant must have been under
pain and suffering for some days. He had to go to the doctor and it
took sometime to completely recover from the injuries. Therefore,
without going to further merits of the case, the compensation on
account of pecuniary loss is enhanced by Rs. 5,000/-. The
enhanced compensation with interest @ 7.5% per annum shall be
paid to the claimant from the date of filing of the claim petition till its
realization.
