1.) In this petition, the petitioner is seeking for a direction to the respondents to release his retiral benefits including monthly pension and further he has sought for medical reimbursement.

2.) Perused the statement of objections filed by respondent Nos.1 and 2. In the said statement, it is admitted that gratuity amount and medical reimbursement claim of the petitioner have been settled. Insofar as retiral benefits of the petitioner are concerned, it is stated that the petitioner has not submitted related papers for disbursement of retiral benefits including monthly pension.

3.) Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in the

month of July, 2015, petitioner has submitted related papers for disbursement of retiral benefits like pension and monthly pension etc. It is further submitted that as on today, retiral benefits of the petitioner and monthly pension have not been settled.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, I direct the respondents to process the pension papers of the petitioner and disburse the retiral dues including arrears of monthly pension etc. to the petitioner within a period of eight weeks, failing which the petitioner is entitled to interest on belated settlement of retiral benefits @ 9% per annum.

5.) Disposed of.
