Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing the impugned order dated 15.09.2003 (Annexure P-1) and impugned office order dated 10.08.2004 (Annexure P-2) and for directions to the respondents to release the complete pensionary benefits and all other consequential benefits alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to comply with the instructions (Annexure R1).

In view of the same, the authority shall determine the amount to be recovered along with interest @12% per annum and thereupon the petitioner shall make a necessary deposit within 6 weeks, thereafter. On doing so, the admissible benefits of the petitioner be released within 8 weeks thereafter.
