Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondent No. 4 to decide legal notice dated 28.07.2015 (Annexure P-2) served by the petitioner wherein he claims that service rendered by him as a work charge employee prior to his regularisation should be counted while calculating his pensionary benefits. It is submitted that no action is being taken by the authorities despite legal notice having been served.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments and the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered expedient to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondent No. 4 to expeditiously decide legal notice dated

28.07.2015 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioners by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
