HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The grievance of the petitioners, who were appointed as Engineering Workers is that they have been working on the post of Oilman/Waterman/Motor Pump Attendant after the requisite approval of the Registrar Cooperative Societies (Sugar Mills) yet they are not being given pay and allowance of officiating post.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that despite repeated representations having been submitted by the petitioners no action thereon has been taken.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of this case this petition is disposed of with a direction to decide the claim of the petitioner in this regard. Liberty shall remain with the petitioners to file a fresh representation with details regarding their

claim.

In case petitioners file representations before respondent No.2 within three weeks from today the same would be disposed of by respondent No.2 expeditiously preferably within three months thereafter.
