Learned counsel for the State of Punjab, while referring to the averments taken in para No.5 of preliminary submissions, in the reply by way of counter affidavit dated 22.01.2015 filed on behalf of respondent No.2, submits that the competent authority is considering the matter. A meeting has been convened for 10th February, 2015 and appropriate order shall be passed thereafter at an early date but

in any case within a period of three weeks after 10th February, 2015.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the respondents as well as learned counsel for the petitioners fairly state that they have got no objection to the proposal put by learned counsel for State of Punjab and the writ petition may be disposed of in terms of statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.2.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Patiala-respondent No.2 to grant an opportunity of being heard to all the interested parties on the date already fixed for the said purpose i.e. on 10th February, 2015. Thereafter, he shall make an endeavour to pass a speaking and reasoned order as early as possible but in any case within a period of three weeks from 10th February, 2015.

With the above said observations made and directions issued, writ petition stands disposed of.
