Heard the submissions made by learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioners.

We find that the writ petitioners aggrieved by the opinion expressed by the Medical Board constituted under the Indian Railways Medical Manual, preferred an appeal as per the Rules in vogue and submitted themselves for re-medical examination and were found again medically unfit to hold the post of Assistant Loco Pilot.

As rightly pointed out by the learned Tribunal, IRMM Rules does not recognise the test being conducted by private institution. No substantial mala fides have been attributed as against the Medical Board constituted as per IRMM Rules.

In view of the above, we find that there is no merit in the writ petition. The writ petition stands dismissed.
