RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, fairly states that he does not intend to press this writ petition for the writ in the nature of certiorari, for the time being. He further submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case their self-contained representation dated 3.11.2014 (Annexure P-8) is directed to be decided by respondent No.3 within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Executive Engineer, Water Services Division, Kurukshetra-respondent No.3, is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioners raised vide their representation dated 3.11.2014 (Annexure P-8), which prima-facie seems

to be genuine and decide the same keeping in view the judgment dated 31.8.2013 passed by this Court in CWP No.13077 of 2010 vide Annexure P-7, at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
