The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing respondents No.2 to 4 to get the amended gift deed, with respect to the 100 square yard plot allotted to the petitioner out of land in Rectangle No.51, Khasra No.17/2, registered forthwith.

Replies filed by Mr. Ravinder, Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Ambala-I and Ms.Surinder Kaur, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Ambala, in Court today, are taken on record.

We have heard counsel for the parties. An appraisal of the reply filed by the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Ambala, reveals that no criminal offence is made out. The Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Ambala-I, has filed a reply that the Gram Panchayat has been directed to submit relevant documents

before the Sub Registrar, Ambala, for registration which as per counsel for the parties have already been submitted.

The writ petition is, therefore, disposed of by directing the Sub Registrar, Ambala, before whom documents have already been filed, in the absence of any legal impediment, to register the documents within a week from receipt of a certified copy of this order, if not already registered.
