As agreed, as per statements of appellant No.5, learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of ₹4,10,000/- (₹ Four Lac Ten Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim, subject to all exceptions. Two months' time is allowed to the Insurance Company to deposit the amount in the bank accounts of the appellants, failing which, interest at the rate of 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. As suggested by learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount would be paid to appellants No.1 and 5, in their given Bank accounts, by the Insurance Company, in the following manner:-

2. **₹1,00,000/-** to Appellant No.5 – Tek Chand, son of Shri Chiman Lal, R/o VPO Kondal, Tehsil Hathin, District Mewat, Gurgaon Gramin Bank, Branch 1166 Kondal, A/c. No.76680100014684 IFS Code PUNBOHGB001

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.
