Prayer in this writ petition is for re-fixation of pension of the petitioner on the basis of his last pay drawn. It is submitted that though the last drawn pay of the petitioner was Rs.18,030/-, however, benefits have been released taking his pay as Rs.16,900/-. Legal notice (Annexure P6) has also been served upon the respondents but no action has been taken thereon till date. It is prayed that respondents be directed to decide the legal notice served upon them and take necessary action.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered expedient to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the competent authority to expeditiously decide legal notice dated 19.08.2015 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
