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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The father of the petitioner, while working as Store Keeper with respondent No.3, expired on 24.05.2006. Vide resolution dated 12.06.2006(Annexure P-4), respondent No.3-Society has decided to pay a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- to the petitioner as exgratia financial assistance. Thereafter, respondent No.3-Society sent communication (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 seeking permission to grant monthly salary of 12 years as compensation in terms of the revised policy/instructions.

Following the same, the petitioner has submitted representations (Annexure P-8 and P-11) to the respondents but no decision regarding grant of benefit of ex-gratia scheme or to pay salary in view of the policy dated 18.11.2005 and 1.8.2006 issued by the State Government has been taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on his representations in

terms of letters (“Annexures P-4 and P-5).

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the claim of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representations dated 15.12.2012 and 15.3.2015 (Annexures P-8 and P-11) in terms of letters dated 12.6.2006 and 15.2.2013 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
