Prayer in this writ petition is for grant of interest on delayed payment of retiral benefits. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite representation dated 18.06.2015 (Annexure P-3) submitted to the authorities, no action has been taken thereon. He prays for direction to the respondents to decide this representation and release benefits.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered expedient to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondent No. 2 to expeditiously decide representation dated 18.06.2015 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner by passing a

speaking order, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
