Order dated 29.12.2014 (Annexure P-5) is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

Application is disposed of.

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Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondents No. 4 and 5 to release retiral dues of the petitioner. It is submitted that petitioner was reinstated in service on 29.12.2014. He superannuated on 31.01.2015. There are no proceedings pending against the petitioner and there is no impediment for release of his retiral dues as well as arrears of salary. However, authorities are not taking action despite representation dated 14.07.2015 (Annexure P-1) submitted before them.

At this stage, it is prayed that the respondents be directed to decide said representation in a time bound manner and afford benefits due to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to expeditiously decide representation dated 14.07.2015 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from receipt of certified copy of this order. Benefits, if any, found due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously preferably within a period of six weeks thereafter.
