DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

Through the present petition, the petitioner seeks appointment on compassionate basis.

It is an uncontroverted fact that the father of the petitioner namely Banwari Lal who was working in the department of Excise and Taxation as an Instructor died in harness on 12.3.1990. It is the case of the petitioner that at the time of the death of his father, he was 4 years old and therefore, on attaining the age of majority, he made a request to the respondents for appointing him on compassionate basis.

After the passage of over 25 years of the death of the father of the petitioner, no relief by way of issuance of direction to the respondents to appoint the petitioner on compassionate basis can be granted as the same would be against the very object for which the compassionate appointment is given.

Consequently, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
