At the very outset, the learned State counsel refers to the chart given in the first para of preliminary submissions of reply by way of affidavit dated 31.03.2014, and states that all the benefits have now been released.

However, the chart does not contain the interest on the delayed payment made by the respondents.

In the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case, the petitioner moves a representation with regard to interest on the delayed payment within three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, the competent authority shall consider and decide the same in terms of the law laid down in

A.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab, 1997(3) S.C.T. 468, and The Financial Commissioner, Haryana Vs. Hasan Singh Kanwar, 2010(1) SLR 788, and if found entitled, consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within four months thereafter.
