Vide letter dated 14.10.2013 (Annexure P-1), the petitioner-firm was allotted work of furnishing of respondent-Bank's building at Plot No.1-6, Sector-5, Panchkula. After completion of the work, referred to above, completion certificate was issued by the respondent-authority certifying that the same has been completed on 02.09.2014. Thereafter, bill amounting to Rs.6.54,62,418/-(Six crore Fifty four lacs Sixty two thousand Four hundred and Eighteen only) was submitted by the petitioner-firm to respondent no.3.

It is stated that though the petitioner-firm has received an amount of Rs.5,87,84,938/-(Five crore Eighty Seven lacs Eighty four thousand Nine hundred and Thirty eight only) but an amount of Rs.66,77,480/- (Sixty six lacs Seventy Seven thousand Four hundred eighty only) is still outstanding against the respondents, which is not being paid despite repeated requests to them.

Learned counsel states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.1 to take a decision on its claim as contained in representation 26.2.2015(Annexure P-5).

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the claim of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as contained in representation dated 26.2.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take a decision thereon in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably, within three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
