Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to register the petitioner provisionally for allotment of paddy during Kharif Marketing Season (KMS) 2015 and allot paddy according to milling capacity of mill of petitioner no.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 has already made an application dated 22.09.2015 (Annexure P/20) for allotment of paddy for the crop year 2015-16. Learned counsel confines his prayer that direction may be issued to respondent no.4 to decide application (Annexure P/20) by passing a speaking order.

perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to respondent no.4 – District Food & Supplies Controller, Yamuna Nagar, to look into the grievance of the petitioners specifically made in application dated 22.09.2015 (Annexure P/20) and pass a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and copy of the order so passed shall be communicated forthwith to the petitioners.
