LISA GILL, J.

Prayer in this writ petition is for directing the respondents to release remaining pension, Gratuity, Leave Encashment, Provident Fund etc. due to the petitioner on account of death of her husband – Puran Chand. It is submitted that despite legal notice dated 28.04.2015 (Annexure P-1) having been served upon the respondents no action is being taken by the authorities. He prays that the respondents be directed to decide representation submitted by the petitioner.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments and the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered expedient to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the competent authority to expeditiously decide legal notice dated 28.04.2015 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of three months from the

date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled to any benefit, same be released within a period of one month from the date of passing of said order.

Present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
