Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents to give the basis, calculations and all documents/court judgments vide which the respondents have fixed the exorbitant final cost of flats of Category-III at Rs.22,46,000/- (First Floor) Rs.21,36,000/- (Second Floor) and Rs.20,81,000/- (Third Floor) vide demand notice dated 15.07.2014 in the scheme known as Super Deluxe Flats of Five Different

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Categories at Sector 79, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

In pursuance of notice of motion, respondent Nos.1 and 2 filed reply with the averments that head-wise amount has been given in Annexure R-1/15.

However, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that list is not properly given and supplied calculation is inadequate. Be that as it may, the fact remains that as per the prayer made in writ petition, calculations are given in Annexure R-1/15.

In view of above, instant petition has become infructuous.

If the petitioners still feel aggrieved by the said calculations, they will be at liberty to move appropriate application/petition to the concerned authority which shall be decided independently in accordance with law without being influenced by this order.
