- 1.) Notice of motion.
- 2.) Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. In view of the order we propose to pass, it is not necessary to seek any reply from the respondents.
- 3.) Two villages Palladi and Nalhar in District Mewat have a common Gram Panchayat. The petitioner who is resident of village Palladi is aggrieved by the establishment of Polling Booth for Ward No.5 in village Nalhar. The petitioner says that the above stated Polling Booth pertains to the voters of village Palladi, hence it ought to have been set up in that village only. He further apprehends that

there might be violence or booth capturing etc. if it continues in village Nalhar only.

4.) The issue raised by the petitioner is essentially administrative in nature which has to be addressed by the Authorities to whom the responsibility of conducting the ensuing Gram Panchayat elections in a fair, impartial and transparent manner has been entrusted. We, thus, dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Mewat and/or any other prescribed authority to consider the petitioner's grievance and take such remedial steps as may be required to enable the voters of Ward No.5 to exercise their right of franchise without any hindrance.
