Learned State counsel submits that all the retiral benefits including DCRG, missing credits of GPF, balance amount of commutation of pension, leave encashment and GIS stands released in favour of the petitioner.

But, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no interest has been paid on the delay of payment.

Since the main relief has been granted to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner may represent to the respondent with regard to the interest and the representation be moved within one month from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. The respondent shall pass speaking and reasoned order on the same within four months thereafter keeping in view the terms of law laid down by Hon'ble Full Bench of this Court in case of **A.S. Randhawa Versus State of Punjab and Others 1997(3) SCT 468.**
