On October 31, 2014, this court had passed the following order:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner concedes that there is no provision for rechecking. If that is so then the prayer of the petitioner cannot be answered.

At this stage learned counsel for the petitioner prays for adjournment to show the relevant rules.

In the interest of justice, the matter is adjourned to 28.01.2015.”

Even on the adjourned date, on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner, the matter was adjourned to 03.07.2015. None has caused appearance even on 03.07.2015, though the matter was called out thrice and was adjourned for 08.07.2015.

The position is not any different even today, as nobody has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner to pursue the matter. That being so, the court is choice-less but to dismiss the petition for non-prosecution.
