The petitioner alleges that the Wards of village Tehna Dipalpur, Block Jatusana, District Rewari have been carved out in total disregard to Rule 4(2) of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Election Rules, 1994. The aforesaid objection was raised by the petitioner vide representation-cum-application dated 17.06.2015. Since the same has not been decided so far, that he has approached

this Court.

Keeping in view the nature of relief sought, we dispose of this writ petition without expressing any views on merits, with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Electoral Officer, Rewari or any other prescribed Authority to redress the above mentioned grievance of the petitioner by way of a reasoned order before the Gram Panchayat elections are held.
