1. Notice to respondents 5 and 6 is dispensed with.
2. Reply filed by way of affidavit on behalf of respondent No.4 is taken on record.
3. There can be no refusal to register a sale deed other than for the reasons which are set out under Sections 71 and 72 of the Indian Registration Act. The order passed by the 2nd respondent, namely, the Deputy Commissioner, Jind, not to register the document is against the law and quashed. I direct the Registering Officer to receive the documents if they have been returned to party and register the same in accordance with law.
4. The writ petition is allowed on the above terms.
