By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 10.04.2014 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner for claim of arrears of family pension.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Som Nath Bhagat, Executive Engineer, Workshop Division, RSD Shahpurkandi Township, District Panthankot, has been filed today in the Court is taken on record.

The learned State counsel states that the entire retiral benefits and interest thereupon from the date of submission of no dues certificate stands already released in favour of the petitioner. The amount of Rs. 3,75,441/- was deposited in the saving bank account No. 10802418569 of the petitioner on 28.01.2015 and the amount of Rs. 78842/- towards interest on the delayed payment from the date of submission of no dues certificate was credited in the account of the petitioner on 26.03.2015.

The above factual position is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
