The petitioners have sought allotment of plot as local displaced persons. The petitioners sought time to produce on record public notice in response to which the petitioners submitted their application for allotment of plot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he is not able to collect any information in respect of advertisement in response where to, the petitioners submitted their application.

The plot as a local displaced person cannot be allotted as and when the application is submitted for allotment of plots. A public advertisement is necessary which alone will allow the Improvement Trust to consider the request of all eligible candidates for allotment of plots.

In view of the said fact, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty submit representation for redressal of their grievance.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
