This civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the retiral benefits as per the revision of pay scale w.e.f 01.01.2006 under the Fifth Punjab Pay Commission and other admissible benefits in the revised pay scales, salary for the month of May 2014 and June 2014 with interest @18% per annum thereon with regard to the service rendered by the petitioner in the Municipal Council, Qadian.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that entire benefits

have been released in favour of the petitioner.

On the above statement, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that though, the entire payment has been released, but the same has been released belatedly. Thus, the learned counsel states that no interest has been paid on the delayed payment.

As the payment has been made, the petitioner is free to make representation to the authority with regard to the interest on delayed payment.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case representation with regard to the payment of interest on the delayed payment, is filed within 45 days from the receipt of certified copy of this order, the respondents shall decide the same in terms of *The Financial Commissioner & Principal Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Irrigation Department, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh and others Vs. Hasan Singh Kanwar, SDO, 2010 (1) SLR 788*, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of such representation.
