The petitioners' contention is that the District Collector is not entitled to refer their matter under Section 30 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 as the award has already been made. The Collector, however, has not decided to refer the matter under Section 30 of the Act. There is no order to that effect. The petitioners can always raise this contention before the Collector who will decide the same. In the event of the Collector deciding to refer the matter under Section 30 of the Act, the petitioners are at liberty to challenge the order.

Petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.
