In this writ petition, the petitioner is seeking writ of mandamus directing the respondents to revise the pay scale of the wife of the petitioner (now deceased) w.e.f. 1.11.1971 or w.e.f date of joining as a Mistress instead of 17.7.1975 in view of the law laid down by this Court in CWP No.2208 of 1989 titled '**Lekh Raj Khera Vs. State of Punjab and another**' and for releasing the arrears of family pension and gratuity in his favour.

2.) The respondents have filed statement of objections and stated that the relief sought by the petitioner has been granted on 26.06.2015. However, the petitioner counsel submits that the

petitioner is entitled for arrears of gratuity amount as well as family pension. The respondents are directed to calculate arrears of gratuity as well as family pension of the petitioner and to pay the same within a period of four weeks. The arrears are restricted to prior to 38 months of filing of the writ petition.

3.) Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of.
