Learned State counsel has filed a short reply by way of affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib in court and the same is taken on record. Copy supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that in terms of the order dated 19.02.2015, not only a cost of ₹ 50,000/- has been deposited, but even the petitioner has been recruited as a Constable in the reserved category for Wards of Freedom Fighter, vide letter No.1784-92/B, dated 12.03.2015, and thus, nothing substantive survives in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the afore-indicated position and prays that the petition be dismissed as having become infructuous.

Ordered, accordingly.
