This Civil Writ Petition has been filed, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of directions to the respondents to release all his retiral benefits in toto along with interest and for interest on delayed payment of General Provident Fund, Leave Encashment and pension arrears as the petitioner retired from the post of Headmaster, Govt. High School Natheha, District Bathinda on 31.05.2012.

Learned State counsel on instructions informs that out of the total amount Rs.1,33,931/- has already been made in favour of the petitioner vide letter dated 15.05.2015. He further states that remaining amount of Rs.67,352/- has also been sanctioned and that will be paid

shortly.

The letter dated 15.05.2015 filed in the Court, is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

Keeping in view the statement made, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to release the sanctioned amount within one month from the receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case the sanctioning amount is not made within the stipulated period, the petitioner shall have the liberty to revive the present petition.
