The only direction given by this Court vide order dated 10.11.2014 (P-7) was that while giving effect to the eviction order passed against the petitioner, which has attained finality, his request to provide a passage to his house may be considered. In deference thereto, the Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Rewari has issued a memo dated 26.08.2015 (P-10) in which it is categorically recorded that B.D.P.O., Bawal has been instructed to provide passage to the petitioner's house from Khasra No.89.

In our considered view, the above-stated decision taken by the authorities is sufficient compliance of the order dated 10.11.2014. If the petitioner has a claim to any other

additional or better passage, which was not the subject-matter of dispute in earlier eviction proceedings, he may raise such a claim before an appropriate forum and in accordance with law.
