The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue their business of running bar and restaurant in accordance with law, as per license granted to them by the respondent authorities and to restrain the respondents from suspending or cancelling their license without giving them any opportunity of hearing. It is further prayed that directions be given to the respondents to grant an opportunity to question any illegal action taken by the respondent authorities with regard to suspension/cancellation of license granted to them.

2. A perusal of the writ petition shows that there is no cause of action which has arisen in favour of the petitioner so as to entitle him to invoke extraordinary writ jurisdiction of this Court at this stage. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
