HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The grievance of the petitioners is that they have not been granted the financial benefits accruing under the Assured Career Progression Scheme, 1999 as well as modified Assured Career Progression Scheme, 2009. Nor have they been granted the financial upgradation in the grade pay of Rs.4200/- despite a circular dated 27.08.2012 issued by the respondents. The petitioners have been repeatedly representing to the respondents but to no avail. Lastly, they have made representation dated 18.06.2015 (Annexure P-9).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 18.06.2015 (Annexure P-9).

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 18.06.2015 (Annexure P-9) expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
