Petitioner, stated to be a private affiliated college, receiving 95% grant-in-aid from the State of Punjab, prays for direction to the respondents to release 95% grant-in-aid due towards the claim of salary of its teaching staff.

Reliance is placed on various orders of this Court whereby directions have been issued to the State to release the grant-in-aid in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite legal notice dated 18.06.2015 (Annexure P-2), no action is being taken by the authorities. He prays that at this stage direction be issued to respondent No.3 to decide legal notice (Annexure P-2).

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered expedient to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the competent authority to expeditiously decide legal notice dated 18.06.2015 (Annexure P-2)

submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
