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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner was working with the respondent-department as Junior Engineer and has since retired on attaining the age of supperannuation.

The grievance of the petitioner is that one Mr. Ramesh Kumar, GSO, who was junior to him, was drawing higher pay than the petitioner since 1.7.2006. Despite sending various representations i.e. 06.03.2013 and 01.06.2015 (Annexures P2 and P-3) to the respondents for stepping up his pay at par with his junior, the petitioner's grievance has not been redressed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No. 4 to take a decision on the aforesaid representations.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to take a decision on the representations dated

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06.03.2013 and 01.06.2015 (Annexures P2 and P-3)
expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the
date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If the petitioner is found entitled to any monetary
benefits, the same be paid to the petitioner within a period of
three months thereafter. It shall be open to the respondents to
restrict the payment of arrears to a period of three years
preceding the filing of this writ petition.
