The tailoring contract of the petitioner has been cancelled before the expiry of the period. The contract in any event comes to an end by 31.3.2016. The respondents have cancelled the same on account of several complaints. We do not wish to express any views on the correctness of the termination of the contract. Suffice it to say that it would include disputed questions of facts. The petitioner is at liberty to adopt proceedings for recovery of damages or compensation.

2. Learned State counsel states that dues of the petitioner, as on date, have been paid. However, counsel for the petitioner is not in position to confirm the same. The petition is, accordingly, disposed of by directing that if, any dues are still pending, the respondents shall pay the same to the petitioner within eight weeks from today.
