The goods have been released. The grievance of the petitioner to that extent stands redressed. However, as a condition for the release, the petitioner was required to pay demurrage and detention charges. According to the petitioner, it was not liable to pay the said charges.

The writ petition is, therefore, disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to adopt appropriate proceedings for recovery of demurrage and detention charges as also in respect of any other claim.
