1. Reply filed by way of affidavit on behalf of respondents 3 and 4 is taken on record.

2. The counsel for the State submits that the office of the respondents 3 and 4 to deal with the application for arms licence came about in 2010 and the records transmitted from the 2nd respondent-District Magistrate, Amritsar, did not include the petitioner's application. The counsel submits that the petitioner's case will be considered if fresh application is given to the respondents 3 and 4.

3. In the light of the submissions, the petitioner shall be at liberty to make an application within a period of 1 week for grant of arms licence in the format prescribed and it will be considered in accordance with law within a period of 12 weeks.

4. The writ petition is disposed of on the above terms.
