Prayer in this writ petition is for release of overtime allowance to the petitioner in terms of decision dated 28th May, 2008 by this Court in CWP-2343 of 2008, Avtar Sharma and others vs. P.R.T.C. and others.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite legal notice dated 17.07.2015 (Annexure P-4), no action has been taken thereon by the respondent till date, who be directed to decide the representation submitted by the petitioner and release the benefit due to the petitioner expeditiously.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on either the merits of the controversy or correctness of the facts mentioned in the writ petition, it is considered expedient to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the competent authority to expeditiously decide legal notice dated 17.07.2015 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any amount is found to be due towards the petitioner, same be released to him within a period of three months thereafter.

Present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
