Prayer in this writ petition is for release of pension and other retiral benefit to the petitioner by counting her entire service rendered in two different government aided schools in terms of the decision dated 17.05.2007 in CWP-14051 of 2005 titled as Ram Lubhaya Khanna and others vs. State of Punjab and others as well as decision dated 23.04.2009 in LPA-63 of 2004.

It is submitted that notice dated 10.07.2015 (Annexure P-8) has been served upon the respondents but to no avail. It is prayed that respondent No.2 be directed to decide notice dated 10.07.2015 served by the petitioner and release the benefit due to the petitioner within four months.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on either the merits of the controversy or correctness of the facts mentioned in the writ petition, it is considered expedient to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the competent authority to expeditiously decide legal notice dated 10.07.2015 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy

of this order. In case any amount is found to be due towards the petitioner, same be released to him within a period of six weeks thereafter.

Present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
